<p><b>The views of the membership in respect of the Grainger Proposals for the re-development of the Moorpool Estate</b></p> <p>The Moorpool Players are without doubt one of the largest –and most visible- of all the major Club/Society stakeholders on the Moorpool Estate.</p> <p>The Players have a thriving and growing membership of over 40 regular members with many more community supporters and Friends who help out as needed.</p> <p>There is a substantial and influential Patrons list of some 84 persons who lend their names and give support to the Players financially. The Group also has a growing mailing list of over 400 names.</p> <p>The Moorpool Players have entertained the Moorpool and the wider community in Harborne and Quinton for 30 years. For many, the Group is synonymous with the Moorpool Hall. The Players have also invested heavily in the Hall over the same period. There is an ever-growing audience for the twice yearly productions of the Group –and the annual show at Christmas- with some 600 hundred tickets sold for each Play.</p> <p>The Players have a wide and deserved reputation and no comparable cultural activity in the community is to be found on this side of the City.</p> <p>The Moorpool Players Committee and membership is therefore very concerned that the present provision and facilities in the Hall are maintained for the local community in the event of any changes to the infrastructure of the Estate.</p>

<p>The views of the membership in respect of the Grainger Proposals for the re-development of the Moorpool Estate</p> <p>Varying views depending on personal details. i.e. members living opposite the club oppose the move to another site resulting in new houses opposite causing traffic problems. Members not resident on the estate would like things to stay the same, BUT if we have to move do not object too strongly as long as we get the type of courts we want and facilities i.e. pavilion including toilets, changing rooms and kitchen.</p> <p>Other members feel the club cannot be forced to move due to the historical value of the site. The Senior Planning Manager of Sports England supports this view as a tennis club has operated on this site for 100 years. However, the courts are nearly as old and would need replacing eventually, which the club cannot do without a long term lease in place(to be able to apply for a loan) which has been refused by whoever has been managing the estate in recent years. We feel the Community Trust will not affect the running of the club wherever we are, but the terms of the trust need to be clarified in case the time came when we would need to renew/repair courts and would need a loan to do so.</p> <p>One other suggestion is that we join the two tennis clubs together and make one club on our site, for example, BUT with four courts, freeing up land on the valley site and possibly making the Circle courts into a public garden/recreational area for children.</p> <p>Even three courts would be acceptable.
